We discussed what a healthy, close working relationship between a PA and the director or principal should look like, along with strategies to foster such a relationship. How to Deal with Work Pressure

We encourage members to share their stressors. Subsequently, we engaged in a dialogue about adjusting one's mindset through introducing and analyzing Festinger Law, (i.e., 10% external; 90% internal), followed by suggesting stress management methods.

Discussions encouraged attendees to identify one aspect of today's session that resonated most with them. We determined that establishing consistent dialogue with supervisors enhances rapport. Furthermore, it was noted that engaging in personal activities during times of professional stress aids in maintaining emotional balance.
